Online Learning

There are two types of online learning in the ALUP Program:

- **Synchronous:**
These online courses feature a real-time, virtual classroom element, where students and instructors 'attend' scheduled online lectures, and interact at the same time. For these virtual classroom sessions, students will require a computer with both audio input and output (such as a microphone-equipped headset).
- **Asynchronous:**
A flexible online experience, where you will move through the course material and activities at the same pace as the rest of the class. There are no real-time virtual classroom sessions to attend.

Face-to-Face/Web-enhanced

- All face-to-face classes (i.e. in-person) are web-enhanced, which is a combination of primarily a face-to-face (in-person) format, with some online components.
- Face-to-face/web-enhanced classes usually require a post-work component to be completed approximately two weeks after the last in-class meeting. Classes will take place in downtown Edmonton, AB at Enterprise Square, unless a different location is specified (check course schedule for more details).
