Switching to the New Program Path Requirements

Students who want to change to the NEW program requirements need to contact the ALUP Program Office **by June 30, 2022** and submit their [Program Declaration](#) form.

Students remaining in the Pre-July 1, 2022 Program Path

Students who wish to remain in the pre-July 1, 2022 program path will have up until June 30, 2024 to complete their requirements. After June 30, 2024, students will be required to Re-Apply to the ALUP Program with the July 1, 2022 Program Requirements.
